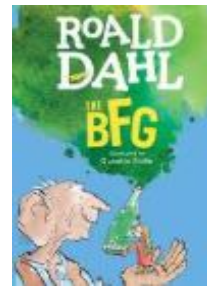
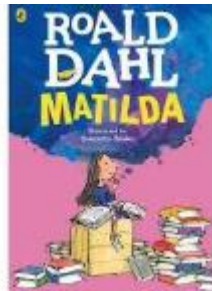


Year 3: Autumn 1
