Well done, Reception—it certainly looks like you had a brilliant time stepping into the shoes of grown-ups for the day!

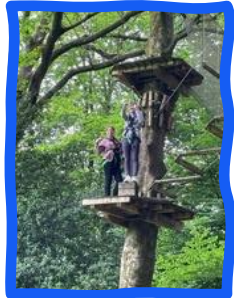

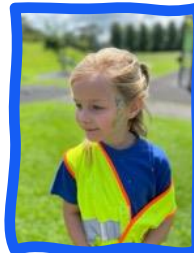
A huge well done to everyone for going above and beyond—literally and figuratively! You should all be extremely proud of yourselves.
