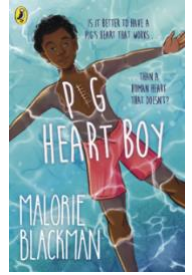


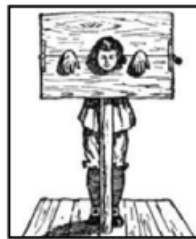
Year 6: Autumn 1

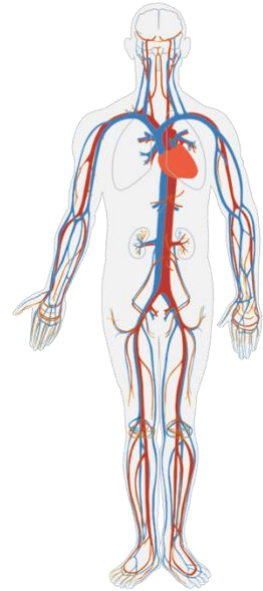

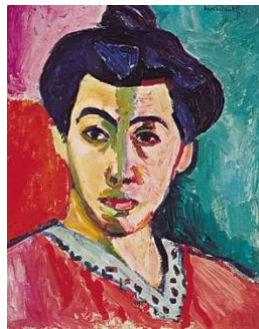
