Mrs Colvin nominated: All of Y4, for their wonderful behaviour at our first swimming lesson yesterday.

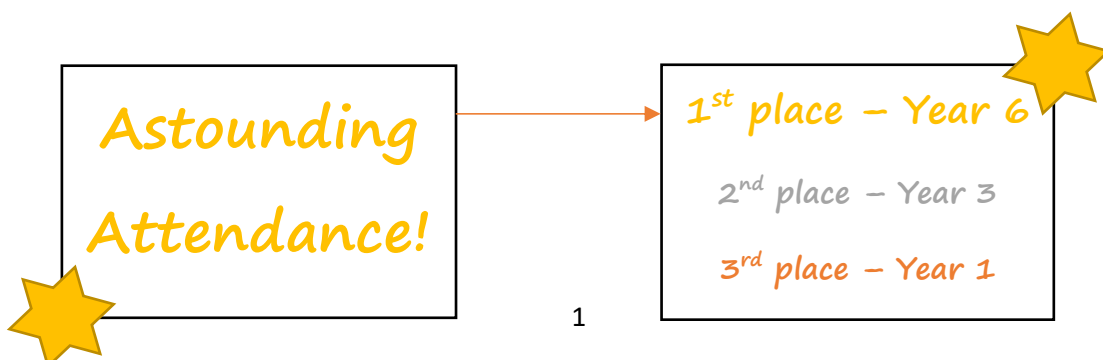
Mrs Agius nominated: Thomas H & Blake A, for trying really hard with fluency when reading out loud.

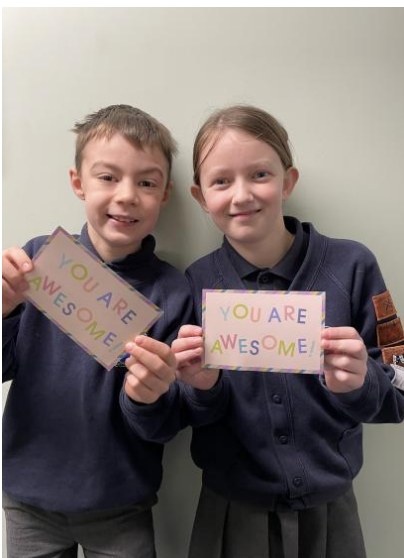
### Deadline Dates for School Applications

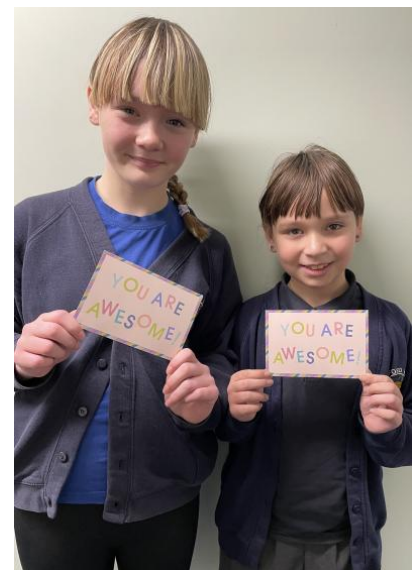
