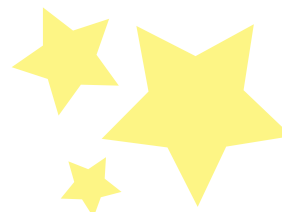

Echo Tribute Festival

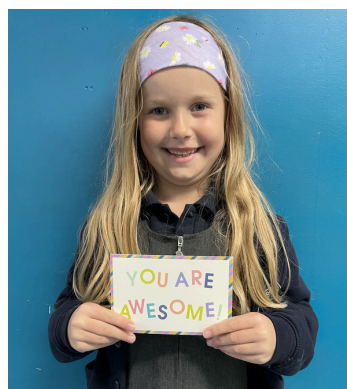
