Fake wounds/sickness-a historical story about The Plague.

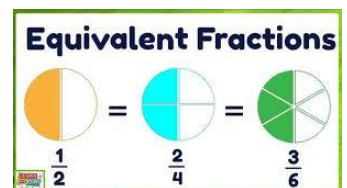
