What are we learning this half term?

Adding and subtracting fractions with different denominators and mixed numbers

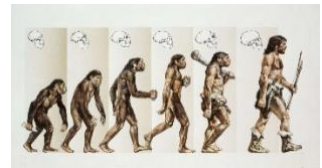
Multiplying simple pairs of proper fractions
