Points for fantastic listening in assembly: Pippa B, Sophie O, Poppy N, Ruben P, Mary-Ann F.

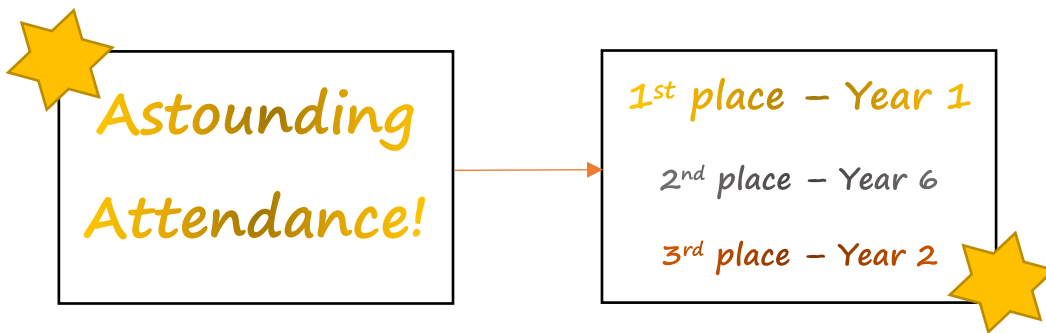
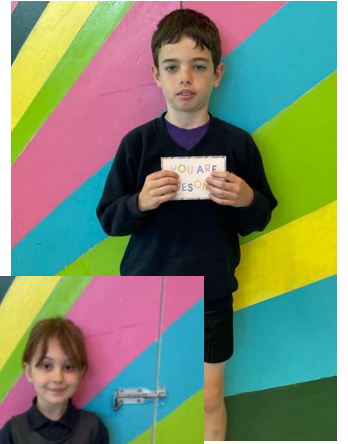
