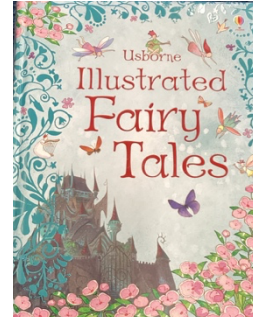
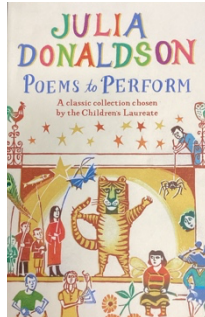
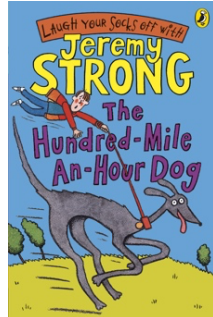


# Year 3: Spring 1 Curriculum Overview

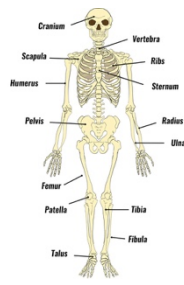
