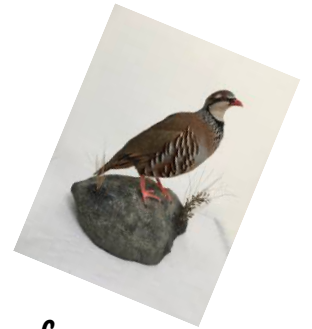


## Year 6: Spring 1 Curriculum Overview

What are we learning this half term?



### English

In English, our writing will be set around developing a set of instructions on how to Taxidermy an animal.

In reading, we have moved onto our second fluency book 'The Memory Thieves' and we will be focussing on practicing our reading comprehension skills.

### Maths

Converting standard units of measurements including length, mass, volume and time and solve problems involving the conversion and calculations up to 3 decimal places.

Rounding numbers and solving problems which involve answers with a fine degree of accuracy.

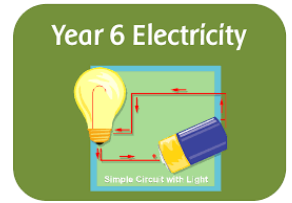
The use of negative numbers in context.

Addition and subtraction multi-step word problems.

Solve problems involving the four main operations.

## Science

We will be looking at *Electricity*; see what components there are in an electrical circuit and how the voltage can affect this. We will look into different circuits to investigate how problems can be identified and how these affect the output of the circuit.



## Geography

Our topic this half term is 'There's No Place Like Home.' We will focus on exploring the local area (Clitheroe), by understanding both the



human and physical features. We will compare different settlements and use fieldwork, map skills, data recording and looking at local landmarks.

## Computing

*Blogging* – The children will create online journals or web pages where they will share their work, using text, images, sound, and videos, with features like comments, hyperlinks, and embedded content for collaborative and engaging projects.
