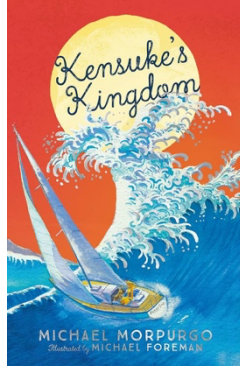
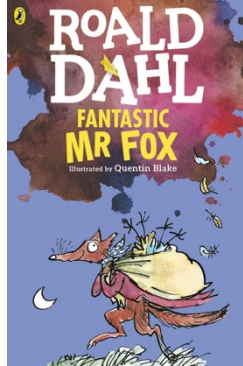


Year 3 : Summer 1 Curriculum Overview

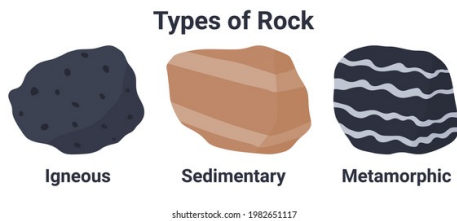

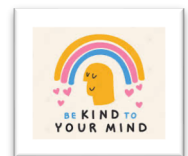
