What are we learning this half term?

English

In English, we will be writing a persuasive piece about a selection of 'Un-useless' Kenji products. As well as beginning to gather our thoughts together to write a recount of Year 6. We will be focussing on reading fluency and building on our vocabulary.



Maths

In Maths, as well as preparing for our SATs week, which is week beginning 11th May; we are also looking at:

- Use simple formulae.
- Number sequences and patterns.
- Algebra and missing numbers.
- Line graphs.
- Pie Charts
- All four operations

Science

Our topic this half term is Living Things and Their Habitats. Children will be identifying the kingdoms of life and classifying living things within those kingdoms. They will be introduced to the Linnean system of classification and will be able to develop their practical scientific skills through investigating mould growth on bread and mushroom spore dispersal.



Geography

Our topic this half term is 'Spain and Catalonia'. We will identify its location, describe and understand both the human and the physical features of the area; whilst making comparisons and similarities to the Islands around the area and main land Spain.
