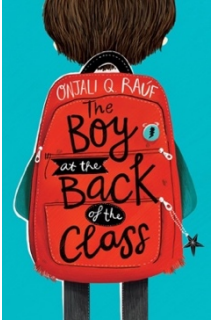


Year 4: Curriculum Overview – Summer 1

Living things and their habitats – We will begin this unit by looking at the different ways we can group animals. The children will have a go at sorting different animals using Venn diagrams and Carroll diagrams.

We will then research different types of habitats, explore how animals can be classified, create a classification key, different adaptations between animal species and how to classify pond plants.

History

Our history topic this term is Low Moor. The children will be taking a look at what Low Moor used to look like, including the houses and the large mill. They will also investigate what life was like for factory workers in comparison to what life was like for the owners of the factory.



Computing

Introduction to AI – This unit introduces pupils to Artificial Intelligence, exploring what it is, what it can do, and how it is used in today’s digital world. Children learn to write clear prompts to communicate effectively with AI tools, consider the responsibilities of being a good digital citizen when using them, and reflect on how AI might evolve in the future.

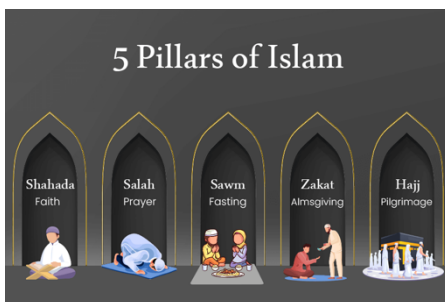


PE
