

Year 6: Summer 2 Curriculum Overview

What are we learning this half term?

English

In English, we will be writing a recount about our time at Edisford, not just in Year 6 but all the way through school, memories, funny anecdotes and exciting things they want to share.



Maths

In Maths, we will be spending much of our time consolidating our knowledge and skills in preparation for KS3. We will also be applying our maths in a much more practical manner through our end of year projects and DT topics e.g. prices for show tickets, prop dimensions and motorised vehicles.

Science

Our topic this half term is 'Looking after the Environment'. The children will explore, using their scientific skills, concepts such as – what climate change is, what causes it, the impact and effects of climate change on the environment, and what people, organisations and governments are doing to combat it.



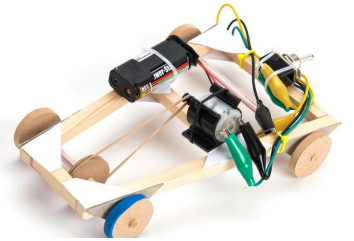
Geography

Our topic this half term is 'Spain and Catalonia'. We will identify its location, describe and understand both the human and the physical features of the area; whilst making comparisons and similarities to the Islands around the area and main land Spain.



DT

We are looking at designing and building our own Motorised Vehicles. The children will develop their understanding of how products can be driven by electricity, whilst using motors within their models and how to control the speed and direction of movement.



Computing

Coding – As well as finishing off our coding topic we are going to be looking at Internet Safety – especially with the move to high school.



PE

Striking and Fielding – we will be looking at playing rounders.

RE

*Christianity – We will discuss and consider the following:
If life is like a journey, what's the destination? We will be delving deeper into salvation and forgiveness.*

PSHE

In PSHE we are going to be focussing on how our bodies will be growing and changing as we get older. As well as looking at how we can grow in confidence when we are performing our Year 6 show; through songs, dances, reading lines and performing to a live audience.
