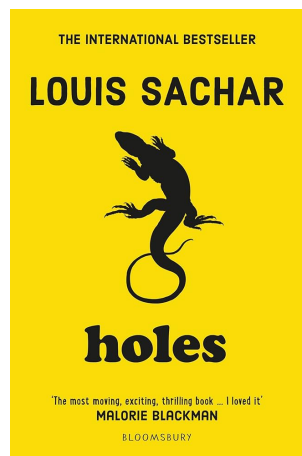

The children will learn how to use search engines to effectively question

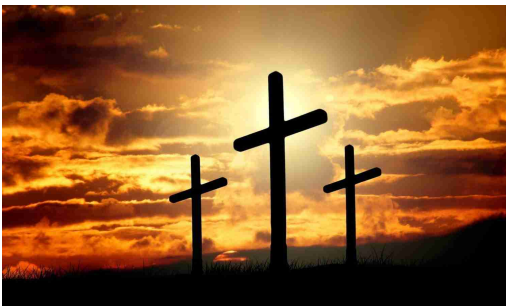
