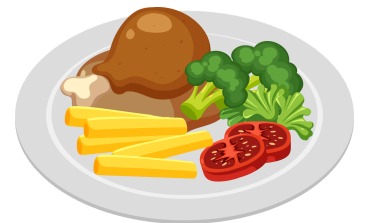
### School Trips

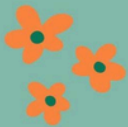
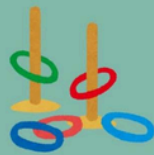
