	<p><u>Animals are Alive!</u> Observe animals including ourselves. Listen to our heart with a stethoscope. Use the MRS NERQ acronym to identify animals as living things.</p>	<p><u>Dinosaur Excavation</u> Learn that dinosaurs lived a long time ago and humans did not co-exist with them. Excavate bones in soil. Look at photos of surviving fossils/bones/teeth.</p>	<p><u>Bird's Eye Map</u> Use a bird's eye map to show the direction a bee takes to find flowers. Forwards, backwards, left and right.</p>	<p><u>Sketching Caterpillars</u> Sketch caterpillars in detail observing closely. Draw what they see, looking back and forth at the caterpillar. Use soft B pencils or charcoal.</p>	<p><u>Animal Toys</u> Observe different wooden toys with moving parts (push along toys). How do they work?</p>	<p><u>Animal Sounds!</u> Sing a range of animal songs such as Animal Song, the Litterbug Song. Use claves to tap the tempo out.</p>	<p><u>Special Places</u> Look at different buildings and show how they are special to different people. E.g. church, hospital, school.</p>	<p><u>Selecting Colours</u> Use Paint Projects in Mini Mash to select colours when painting on the computer.</p>
	<p><u>Habitats</u> Where do animals live? Describe different habitats and what animals need to survive in their habitat. Sort wild and domestic animals.</p>	<p><u>Prehistoric Timeline</u> Learn that the dinosaur period was so long that it has to be divided into different parts. Order Triassic (first dinosaurs and mammals appear), Jurassic (first birds, more dinosaurs), Cretaceous (flowering plants appear, dinosaurs disappear).</p>	<p><u>The Hungry Caterpillar</u> Use directional language to direct a caterpillar to its food (role play) using a blindfold to encourage directional language.</p>	<p><u>Caterpillar Prints</u> Print caterpillars using potatoes. Use different colours to show their bright hues.</p>	<p><u>Peg Bees</u> Design bees using different materials. Give a choice of pegs and use materials to form different parts of the bee (abdomen, legs, head, antennae).</p>	<p><u>Call and Response</u> Sing Hickety Pickety Bumblebee and The Animal Song. Practise call and response, composing a reply.</p>	<p><u>BBC Soocial Places</u> Read the story about animals and special places. Rosie has a favourite armchair. Draw a picture of our special place. Special places - BBC Teach</p>	<p><u>Mark Making</u> Be able to mark make purposefully on the screen. Use 2Paint a Picture Simple Mode in the Drawing and Painting Area.</p>
	<p><u>Life Cycles of Animals</u> Observe caterpillars growing and how they make a chrysalis and metamorphose into butterflies. Read the Hungry Caterpillar.</p>	<p><u>Match Dinosaurs</u> Use photo evidence of skeletons and match to each dinosaur. Historians use evidence to find out about the past. Use magnifying glasses to study the skeletons.</p>	<p><u>Save our Animals!</u> Look at different pieces of rubbish and how animals can be hurt by them. Rescue toy animals from a net and count them as they go.</p>	<p><u>Caterpillar Sculptures</u> Use paper to make caterpillars by making paper chains.</p>	<p><u>Rubbish is Rubbish</u> Make a different animal using reused materials. Show that it is important to reuse materials in technology. Create a stable structure.</p>	<p><u>Animals in Action</u> Sing different animal action songs e.g. Old MacDonald, Animals in Action by Jack Hartmann.</p>	<p><u>Safe Homes</u> Discuss how we all have a home and need to feel safe in our homes. Match the right habitats to the animals.</p>	<p><u>Choosing Tools</u> Draw with a range of tools in the Purple Mash Drawing Tools area. E.g. flood fill.</p>
	<p><u>Birds</u> Explore where birds live and what they need to survive. Observe birds in their habitats.</p>	<p><u>Ordering Dinosaurs</u> Order dinosaurs from the earliest to the latest.</p>	<p><u>Rubbish is Rubbish</u> Sort rubbish into different types for recycling. Discuss why it is important to recycle our materials.</p>	<p><u>Bee Sculptures</u> Make bee sculptures out of playdough. Add different materials for parts of the body.</p>		<p><u>Musical Animals</u> Use different percussion instruments to make different animal sounds.</p>	<p><u>Church Visit</u> Visit St Paul's Church and spot different features of the church. What does it feel like?</p>	<p><u>Undo and Erase</u> Use the undo and the erase buttons in Paint Projects and 2Paint a Picture.</p>
	<p><u>Dinosaurs</u> Understand that dinosaurs once lived on Earth. Explain the different types of dinosaurs and that dinosaurs have similarities with creatures today.</p>					<p><u>Listen to the Animals</u> Listen to The Flight of the Bumblebee and Carnival of the Animals. Which animals can you hear?</p>
