Mrs Colvin nominated: Zachary W, Oliver L and Max K, for respecting the teachers and other adults decision about ball games on the yard.

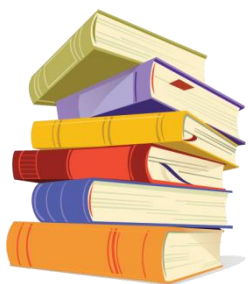

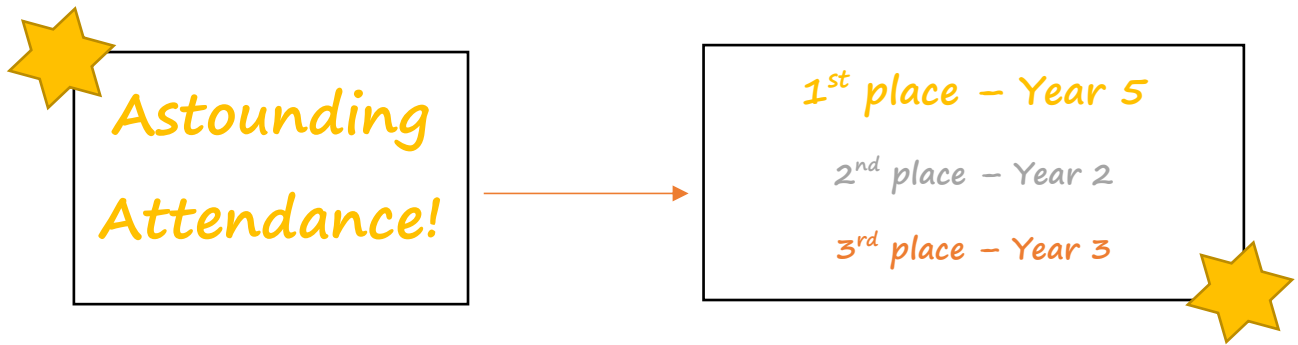
