All of Year 4, for having great enthusiasm and amazing manners during their transition session.

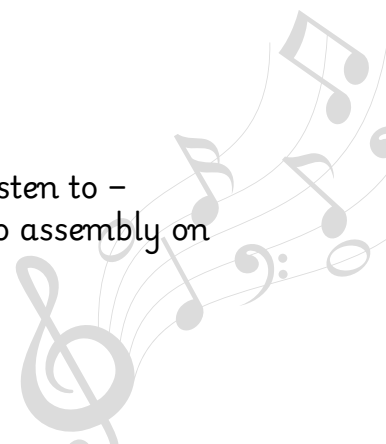
Mrs Chadwick & Mrs Dryden nominated: All of Year 6, for approaching their High School visit days with positivity and maturity.

### Pupil Premium

Pupils who are eligible for FSM receive additional funding called 'Pupil Premium'. The pupil premium means that even if you don't wish for your child to access a free hot meal at school each day, being eligible will mean that our school will receive further funding. This means you can get extra financial support with other aspects of school life. For example, pupils who receive pupil premium/free school meals receive one school uniform voucher per year, to help with the cost of school uniforms. During the holidays, PP children also receive supermarket vouchers, to help with the cost of food shopping. Free places at our holiday club are also offered to children on free school meals.

Your child is eligible for free school meals if you're in receipt of certain benefits. You can check if you are eligible and apply for free school meals on
